

## USGA Handicapping System Requirements

Dear Members,

### Failure to submit scorecards for 6 continuous months will result in members' Handicap Index becoming INACTIVE

We wish to inform you that many members still do not submit their scorecards after games played, despite several reminders on Internet, our RV magazine, and notices around the Club-house. Members may wish to know that Scorecard can be submitted through NSRCC's website from the comfort of your home. Please feel free to call Membership Centre at 65408555 should you need a login password.

We also wish to inform members that **failure to submit scorecards for 6 continuous months will result in members' Handicap Index becoming INACTIVE**. Members' handicap Index in this "INACTIVE (S)" category will not be posted to SGA for display on its handicap index website. Furthermore, players whose handicap index are in INACTIVE (S) category are not eligible to take part in home and/or away golf tournaments, unless otherwise players seek prior approval from the respective Tournament Directors/Chairman Handicap Committee. *Members are strongly advised to check his or her handicap index STATUS and ELIGIBILITY before enrolling for any club or private golf tournaments. Failure to do so runs risk of being disqualified by the organiser before or after the tournament.*

Members' INACTIVE handicap index status will remain in this category until he or she submits a scorecard for computation and posting of handicap index by the club, which is scheduled for the FIRST day of each month.

#### **Members shall also note that:**

#### **Scores on All Courses**

Player must post *Adjusted gross scores* from all courses with a *USGA Course Rating* and *Slope Rating*, both at home and away. *If a player fails to post an acceptable score* as soon as practical after completion of the round, the handicap committee will post the score and/or a *penalty score and ratings equal to the lowest handicap differential* in the player's scoring record.

#### **Posting a Score When a Complete Round is not Played**

If 13 or more holes are played, the player must post an 18-hole score. If 7 to 12 holes are played, the player must post a nine-hole score. In either case, scores for unplayed holes must be recorded as *par* plus any handicap strokes that the player is entitled to receive on the unplayed holes.

**Example:** A player with a *Course Handicap* of 24 stops playing after 16 holes because of darkness. Hole 17 is a *par* 3 and is the number 18 *handicap-stroke hole*. The player will record 3 (*par*) plus 1 handicap stroke for an X-4 on hole 17. Hole 18 is a *par* 4 and is the number 2 *handicap-stroke hole*. The player will record 4 (*par*) plus 2 handicap strokes for an X-6 on hole 18.

- Practice on the course is prohibited (golfer to play only one ball).

Pin Position: Back (Blue), Middle (Yellow), Front (Red)

Pin Flag: Blue, Yellow, Red

Indicate 1st which tee used: Blue, White, Red
