

USGA Handicapping System Requirements

Dear Members,

Submission of Scorecard

The USGA Handicapping System mandates an automatic submission of penalty score/s equal to the Lowest Handicap Differential in all scoring records as a result of non-submission of scorecards. In this regard, we would like to remind all members to submit their scorecards every time they play a round of 9 or 18 holes golf game at NSRCC golf course as well as games played in other “away” courses.

The cut-off date for Non Submission is 3 days before the end of each month. Games played in NSRCC during days with Category-1 (Lightning Risk) condition will not be monitored for non-submission. We will monitor members who have 30% or more of their scoring records containing penalty scores. These members may have their Handicap Index withdrawn as decided by the Handicap Committee without any further notice. Once the Handicap Index is withdrawn, there will not be any handicap card issued to members. These members will be required to attend a courtesy round to ascertain their suitability for inclusion into USGA Handicap System. Members are still allowed to play social game at NSRCC course but not the club events.

Members are strongly advised to check his or her handicap index STATUS and ELIGIBILITY before enrolling for any club or away golf game/tournament. Failure to do so runs risk of being disqualified by the club/organizer before or after the game/tournament.

Members shall also note that player must post Adjusted Gross Scores from all courses with a USGA Course Rating and Slope Rating, both at home and away. If a player fails to post an acceptable score as soon as practical after completion of the round, the score and/or a penalty score as mentioned in Para 1 will be posted by the Handicap Committee.

As for posting a score when a complete round is not played, player shall note that if 13 or more holes are played, the player must post an 18-hole score. If 7 to 12 holes are played, the player must post a nine-hole score. In either case, scores for un-played holes must be recorded as par plus any handicap strokes that the player is entitled to receive on the un-played holes. For example:

A player with a *Course Handicap* of 24 stops playing after 16 holes because of darkness; and if Hole # 17 is a *par* 3 and the number 18 *handicap-stroke hole*, the player will record 3 (*par*) plus 1 handicap stroke for an X-4 on Hole # 17. And if Hole #18 is a *par* 4 and the number 2 *handicap-stroke hole*, the player will record 4 (*par*) plus 2 handicap strokes for an X-6 on Hole #18. A sample of the scorecard submission for “un-completed” game is shown below:

- All golfers must be suitably dressed according to Club's Bye-laws.
- Practice on the course is prohibited (golfer to play only one ball).

Course Closure: One sense of ball "Sotto Course Close" Resume Play: One sense of ball "Sotto Course Open"

Pin Position: Back (Blue), Middle (Yellow), Front (Red)

All Members are reminded that failure to submit score card will automatically incur a penalty score of net 3 under par of the course rating.
